

Special Contest Opportunity!!!!

Are you interested in engineering, building, or have a creative side? Do you want to help GCCAS win up to \$5,000 for the school? Here's your chance!

Between the first day of school and November 1st I will be asking for a volunteer crew of 6-10 dedicated individuals to help construct a milk carton structure that represents "transportation" at its finest.

I would like for the sixth graders of GCCAS to show the Made By Milk community what we can do by working together to create a creative and unique representation of a piece of transportation.

The rules are simple:

- We must collect, clean, dry and use a minimum of 100 intact milk cartons.
- Build a piece of transportation (think plane, train, automobile, space ship, etc...) that is mostly milk cartons, but can contain up to 20% other recyclable materials.
- Upload up to 4 pictures by the due date and collect vote online.
- Write a 200 word, or less, essay explaining how we would use the award money.
- Receive extra credit for using over 100 cartons, painting the structure, creating something unusual or unique, or coming up with an idea for using the award money for a green initiative at our school or in the community.

In addition to the contest rules, I ask that any student that would like to be a part of the build team commit to being a part of the team and coming to meetings/building sessions scheduled in advance.

Are you up to the challenge? Do you want to be a part of the team? The first 6-10 students who can commit to the project will be a member of the team. Please sign and return the bottom portion of this form to secure your spot!
